Everyone deserves a place to *feel safe*

Safe housing is the foundation for a stable life. Without security, learning and healing are impossible. This year, our safe housing program provided stability for vulnerable families facing crisis.

We supported:

- 2 single mothers and their children
- 1 grandmother caring for her grandchildren

For mothers pursuing training and employment, safe housing removed the constant fear of homelessness and allowed them to focus on building a future for their children.

Families moved from survival mode into stability—creating the space needed for education, employment, and long-term independence.

Outcome

Hospitality & Leadership Training Program

A hands-on training program designed to equip students with practical hospitality, leadership, and workplace skills. The program baking, hotel departments, exposure trips, and barista coffee skills.

- Exposure visits to hotels, guesthouses, cafés, and restaurants
- Students gained confidence, professionalism, and clear pathways into employment—breaking cycles of unemployment and dependency.

Adventure Kids Outreach (VBS)

A two-day outreach designed to bring joy, share Christ, and reach the vulnerable children in the community.

- 300 children reached
- 35 volunteers trained and equipped
- Organized games, dance, and Bible lesson
- Orphans and children with special needs loved and cared for.

Education & Essential Support

Removing barriers that prevent children and students from attending and staying in school.

- 9 enrolled with daily hot meals
- Clothing and uniforms
- Menstrual & hygiene kits
- Children remained in school with dignity, focus, and consistency.

With strong foundations in place, we are preparing for intentional growth to serve more people—more sustainably and effectively.

Growing our Barista & Hospitality Training

Expanding Barista & Hospitality Training
Building on the success of our Hospitality & Leadership program, we plan to:

- Train more students each year
- Secure more equipment for hands-on learning and workplace exposure
- Partner with a cafe to create a clear pathway into employment

- Expand our work in Uganda, reaching more children, students, and families through our mission programs.
- Explore new partnerships and opportunities globally, so we can respond faithfully to needs wherever they arise.


Registering as a Canadian Nonprofit

From Survival to Hope

When she first came to us, she was carrying more than exhaustion—she was carrying the weight of trauma.

A young single mother of two, her life had been shaped by a traumatic violation and years without safety or support. With no formal schooling and no role models to guide her, she found herself trapped in a cycle of abuse and survival she desperately wanted to escape. To provide for her children, she worked long, grueling hours in an unsafe maize factory, grinding corn into flour day after day. The work was exhausting and dangerous, yet it was her only means of survival. Each day was about getting through; each night was filled with worry. Through the sponsorship of a donor, she was given the opportunity to enroll in our Hospitality & Leadership training program. At the same time, her children were welcomed into our safe house, where they received consistent care and stability. Her oldest child was enrolled in elementary school, beginning a new chapter of safety and learning.

For the first time, she could focus on her training knowing her children were safe.

Despite deep insecurity and limited education, she showed remarkable determination. She committed to making the most of the opportunity before her.

By the end of the program, she had become one of the strongest students in her class. The hotel where she completed her training recognized her dedication and offered her a job immediately upon graduation.

With stable income, she was now able to provide for her family with dignity. Her children had safety and routine, and she was no longer living in survival mode—she was building a future.

This December, she registered her daughter for our Adventure Kids VBS outreach using her own hard-earned wages. Her smile was contagious.

That quiet moment captured the heart of our mission.
